

What is an Escape Room?

Escape Games are a **FAMILY-FRIENDLY, INTERACTIVE ADVENTURE EXPERIENCE** that puts your guests in the middle of an immersive storyline with a task to solve in 60 minutes or less.

Usually played in groups of 4 to 8, escape games offer a **SAFE, PRIVATE AND VERY ADDICTIVE ACTIVITY** that can transform your unused or little used meeting space into a **MONEY-MAKING MACHINE**.

In the beginning guests are shown a video or told a story and given a mission. Then they enter a themed room, perhaps a pirate ship, a Mayan Temple, a genie's lamp or a serial killer's lair. There they will be confronted with a series of puzzles and interactive tasks that will challenge their mind and their ability to work as a team.

With each successive achievement in the game, players edge closer to their final victory. Along the way they will uncover **SECRET DOORS AND PASSAGEWAYS** to new chambers and even more puzzles.



Once **SUCCESSFUL** in their mission a photo is taken to record their victory. This photo is a **TREASURED MEMORY** and frequently shared on social media.

It is important to note that escape rooms are very safe. Entrance and exit doors are never locked and guests can leave at any time.

Games are monitored by a gamemaster through cameras and microphones and rooms are reset and cleaned between groups.

Escape games started in Asia and moved through Eastern and then Western Europe in the mid-2000s. They arrived in North America in 2014 and continue as a rapidly growing entertainment genre.
